**ADMISSION TO UNDERGRADUATE COURSES IN
MAHATMA GANDHI GOVT. COLLEGE MAYABUNDER FOR THE
ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-24**

The Provisional Merit List of candidates seeking admission for the Academic Year 2023-24 in various UG courses in M.G. Govt College, Mayabunder has been published online. All the candidates seeking admission should attend the counselling with their Parents/ Guardians along with all Original Certificates and adequate number of Xerox Copies at the time of counselling without fail. If the provisionally admitted candidates fail to deposit the prescribed fee in the time bound period of 3 days from the date of admission, his/her admission in the said course will be cancelled and the seat will be given to the next candidate on the basis of Waiting Merit List. The Provisionally Admitted candidates seeking for Hostel Accommodation should collect their Forms from the Auditorium, i.e. the place of counselling on the day of Admission. As there are limited seats available in the Girls/Boys Hostels, the Hostel Accommodation shall be provided purely on the basis of Merit.

The Counselling for Admission in various UG Courses at MG Govt. College, Mayabunder will be held as per the scheduled date and time given below:


