

PRESS RELEASE

The category-wise final list of candidates applied for admission to Four Years Integrated Courses viz. B.A.B.Ed. (English), B.A.B.Ed. (Hindi), B.A.B.Ed. (History) and B.Sc.B.Ed. (Maths) in Tagore Govt. College of Education, Port Blair has been published on 22nd October 2020 at 4:00 p.m. after attending claims and objections for information of all concerned and is available at <http://collegeadmission.andaman.gov.in/> under “Announcements”.

The counselling for admission to these courses shall be held from 29th October to 7th November 2020 from 9:00 a.m. in the Tagore Auditorium. On 29th and 31st October, counselling in English for Category-III and counseling in Maths, Hindi and History for Category-III will be held respectively. Similarly, on 2nd and 3rd November, counseling in English for Category-IV counseling in Maths, Hindi and History for Category-IV will be held respectively. On 4th November 2020, counseling for the candidates under Category-I, II, EWS and PwD for all subjects will be held. On the last day of counseling i.e. on 7th November 2020, counseling for left out seats and Category-V will be held. The exact time and venue may be seen from the above dashboard.

Candidates selected for admission to these courses during counselling session shall be given admission on the same day and online classes shall begin immediately. The selected candidates should deposit the fees and all required original certificates on the day of admission failing which their cases for admission will not be considered.

Those who fail to attend the counselling session, in time, will not be considered for admission to the course and next eligible candidate in the merit list will be considered for admission.

However, if any candidate from outer islands is unable to attend the counseling due to sudden breakdown of transportation, Covid-19 restrictions, containment zone etc., they are requested to intimate their position over telephone/WhatsApp in anyone of the given numbers (Mobile No. 9434282037, 9434280223, 241345) well in advance so that their claim for admission can be protected during counseling. Such information should reach at these phone numbers well before counselling. **If no information is received, next eligible candidate will be considered for admission.**
