ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

UG COURSES

Candidates for seeking Admission to Undergraduate Courses are required to have passed:

1. The Higher secondary, Intermediate or Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination conducted by the Central or state Govt. Board
OR
2. The Pre-University/Pre-degree Examination of a recognized University.
OR
3. Any other qualification equivalent to the above mentioned qualification approved by the Academic Council of the University.
4. For B.Com (Commerce) and B. Com. (Co-operative Management) Degree only those who have offered Commerce or Accountancy at the plus two level are eligible for admission in respective stream.
5. Students must have passed English as a paper in the qualifying examination.

COURSE STRUCTURE FOR UG PROGRAMMES

Each Course consists of the following:

Part-I: language (Any one) under the option of the candidate such as Hindi/Bengali/Tamil/Telugu.

Part-II: English.

Part-III: includes discipline specific courses both compulsory and Electives and skill Enhancement courses, Ability Enhancement compulsory courses and Generic Elective courses.

SEAT RESERVATION

In accordance with the policy of Govt. of India and the guidelines of the University Grants Commission and Pondicherry University, criteria of seat reservation are followed in all the courses offered in the college, for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. All ST candidates who have passed the qualifying examination are eligible to apply for any course irrespective

of percentage of marks. The existing distribution criteria/Formula for reservation of seats in M.G.Govt. college, Mayabunder is given below:

COLLEGE LIBRARY

About Library

The College has a library with nearly Seventeen thousand volumes in all the relevant subjects and subscribes nearly 50 journals. The Students can borrow three books at a time. Silence shall be maintained in the Library premises. Mobile phones are not permitted in Library.

NCC/NSS

The college has NCC Naval Wing (Boys & Girls) senior division. The college also has National Service Scheme (NSS) with one unit for Girls and another for Boys, having total annual intake of 200 NSS Volunteers. Admission is given to those undergraduate students who can continue in the Scheme for two years.

HOSTEL FACILITY

- Subject to the rules and regulation/guidelines as per A & N Administration the Hostel will be allocated to the students.
- All the first year students shall be permitted to go outside of the hostel subject to the letter granted by the parents.
- Students should strictly adhere to the hostel rules and regulation.
